

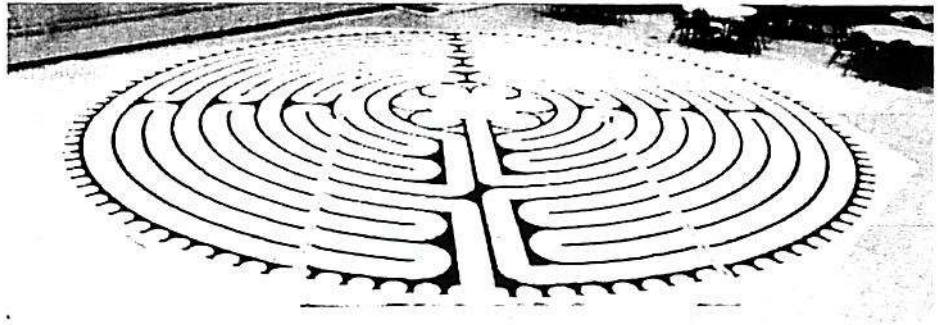
Setting up a 3-piece 36 foot Canvas Labyrinth

1. Be certain the floor is dry and recently cleaned.
2. Open the storage container and, using at least two people, remove the three labyrinth sections.
3. Find the section marked ENTRANCE and position that edge where the desired entrance will be.
4. Unroll this labyrinth section completely so you have one long length of folded fabric. Adjust the position of the labyrinth in the center of the room.
5. Using several people, open the first lengthwise fold, so you have one long folded section on each side of the center. Repeat with the other side.
6. Make note of which strip of Velcro (soft or sticky) is on each edge of the center. Remove the side sections and align them so the opposing Velcro strip lies adjacent to the center section.
7. Unfold the side sections completely, slightly away from the center section so the Velcro edges don't touch. Align the sides so the painted lines match from center section to side section.
8. On one side, fold back the sticky Velcro edge and slide the side section toward the center so that the Velcro will overlap when folded back down.
9. Begin at the center of the labyrinth and fold the Velcro edge down along one side, completely overlapping and connecting the Velcro, first at the painted lines and smoothing the spaces between. Work outward to the perimeter, smoothing and repositioning as needed so the painted lines match.
10. Return to the center and repeat steps 8 and 9 to the opposite edge of the same side.
11. Repeat steps 8 -10 for the other side panel.
12. Adjust any areas needed by separating the Velcro and repositioning. Pull/tug at the outer edges of the canvas to smooth out the entire labyrinth. Use the labyrinth broom as necessary to smooth out wrinkles.

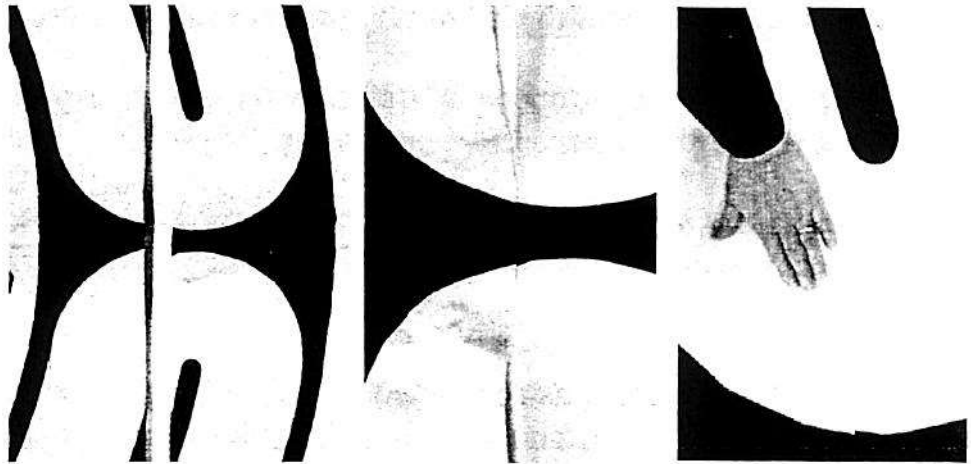

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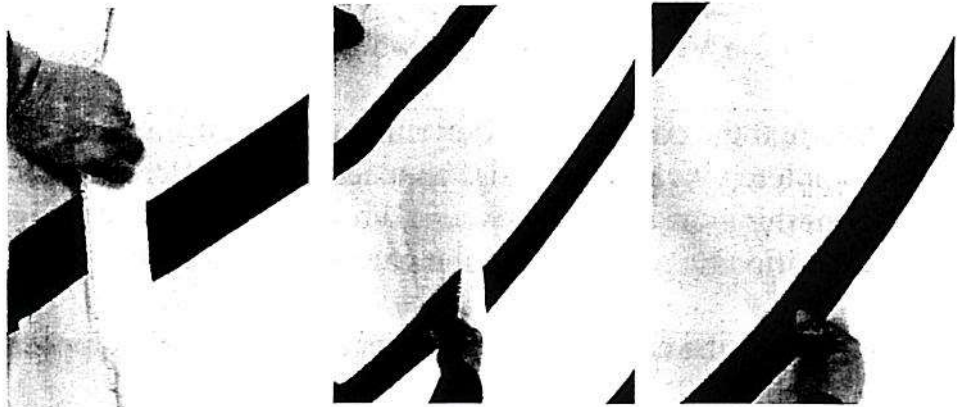
Steps 4-7: Lay out center section first, then position the two side sections next to the center section, with the Velcro edges about an inch apart.



Step 8: Begin at the center on one side of the labyrinth. Stand on the center section (stocking feet only, please). Line up the painted lines. Lift or fold back the center Velcro edge slightly and pull the side section toward the center to overlap the Velcro edges. Press the Velcro together at the painted line. Match the next painted line to one side, then smooth out the canvas between the painted lines.



Step 9: Continue moving down one side from the center to the outer edge, pulling the sections to overlap the Velcro and match the painted lines.



Step 10: Repeat Step 9 moving from the center toward the opposite outer edge on the same side.

Step 11: Repeat steps 8-10 for the other side section.

Step 12: Adjust any areas needed by separating the Velcro and repositioning. Pull/tug at the outer edges of the canvas to smooth out the entire labyrinth. Use the labyrinth broom as necessary to smooth out wrinkles.
